



Classroom Instrumental Learning (CIL) instrument insurance

Schools are responsible for any instruments that are loaned to them by DDMP for a CIL programme, but whether you need additional insurance depends on factors specific to individual schools and programmes.

❓ Will instruments be insured whilst on-site for repair/replacement with any existing insurance your school has?



❓ Will instruments go home with pupils to practise?



❓ An instrument is lost/damaged. What do we do?

In the first instance, take a photo of the instrument (if not missing), then talk to your programme Deliverer. They will do an initial assessment, fix it if they know how, or will contact DDMP to report a damaged/lost instrument. DDMP will contact the school for next steps when we know what they might be.
